Logues Bush Scenic Reserve car park, off Day Road, Tomarata	Long: 174.587906756 Lat: -36.257609	Recommendation is to allow self contained camping only under Freedom Camping legislation because there are no toilets or tap facilities and there is evidence of human waste around the entrance to the car park from time to time. There have been requests for the installation of a toilet and non self-contained camper vans are seen camping from time to time.
The area of sand dunes, duneland and wetland west of "Coast Road" to the Tasman sea. Also commonly known as the Bombing Range or NZDF Air Weapons Range.	Long: 174.181185 Lat: -36.462193	Camping is prohibited by NZ Defence legislation, public ban - unexploded ordinance and Air Weapons (Bombing) Range. Intent flagged in current CMS to prohibit camping but no bylaw created. Public safety risk. Recommendation is to prohibit under Freedom Camping legislation so DOC can enforce for safety reasons.
All that area of dune and scrub lands between the Kaipara harbour and farm land on the western end of the Taporā Peninsula.	Long: 174.260754 Lat: -36.360960	Intent flagged in current CMS to prohibit camping but no bylaw created. Recommendation is to prohibit under Freedom Camping legislation because of; shore bird disturbance in the breeding season, rubbish being left on site, vegetation being cut and fires lit. Neighbours have been harassed. Camping is frequent during holiday periods. There is a lot of file evidence available if required.
The dune and scrub island above MHWS west of the Taporā Peninsula, joined by sand at low water, and opposite the Kaipara Harbour entrance.	Long: 174.241228 Lat: -36.376638	Intent to prohibit camping flagged in current CMS but no bylaw created. Recommendation is to prohibit (option D) under Freedom Camping legislation. Site is a wildlife mgt reserve where camping disturbs nesting shore birds and fernbirds. There is a history of vegetation clearance to create campsites, lighting fires
A narrow sand spit north and north west of Waionui Inlet, South Kaipara Heads, which is sometimes an island and at times joined to Rangitira Beach	Long: 174.201571 Lat: -36.430078	Intent to prohibit camping flagged in current CMS but no bylaw created. Recommendation is to restrict camping (option C) to self-contained vehicles only under Freedom Camping legislation. Site is critically important for nesting of fairy tern and is adjacent to Papakanui Stewardship Area. Exclusion of shore camping from Papakanui would force fishermen into the smaller site and create disturbance to nesting birds.
